PROPER HANDLING AND CARE FOR INKJET INKS

Inkjet inks are ultra-clean fluids which have been processed through a very fine filtration system, and make them very sensitive to debris, etc. Any improper handling such as touching by hand, leaving uncapped, transferring with incompatible tubing and storing in a wrong container, will definitely contaminate the ink and eventually lead to the malfunctions in the print head, such as clogging.

Here are some guidelines:

1. Ink should only come into contact with tubing and bottling made from the following materials: -PE, -PP, -or Teflon made plastics.
2. Do not use the PE or PP syringe with a rubber plunger.
3. Anything coming into contact with Inkjet ink must be thoroughly washed with distilled or deionized water.
4. Store inks at room temperature indoors.
